



COTR Elk Valley Resident Entrance Bursaries are open to first-year students entering a full-time post-secondary program at College of the Rockies. Elk Valley Resident Entrance Bursaries, ranging from \$250 tuition bursary to \$1,000 tuition bursary, are available to students who demonstrate financial need. Application to StudentAid BC and Notification of Assessment must accompany application.

COTR Elk Valley Resident Entrance Bursaries are for students entering the College of the Rockies for the first time who meet the eligibility requirements.

Eligibility

To compete for Elk Valley Resident Entrance Bursary applicants must:

- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident;
- Be a resident of the Elk Valley for the past two years or a graduate of an Elk Valley Secondary School within the past two years;
- Enter a full-time post-secondary program for the first time. Minimum enrolment of a 60% (40% for students with a documented disability) course load;
- Demonstrate financial need;
- Apply for BC Student Assistance Program and provide a copy of your Notification of Assessment with entrance bursary application;
- Apply for the Elk Valley Resident Entrance Bursary by the application deadline.

Selection

Elk Valley Resident Entrance Bursaries are awarded based upon:

- Financial need;
- Student essays:
 - 1.) Briefly describe your academic and career goals. Why you chose to study at College of the Rockies?
 - 2.) Briefly describe the activities in which you have participated as a volunteer in the community at large. For activities in which you took a leadership role, briefly state why it was important for you to assume the role of leader.

Application Instructions

1. Student Application

- Complete the Student Application form. Applications must be typed. You can type in the application form and print the form to submit.

2. Essays

- Complete the student essays, each a maximum 125 words. It's best to type your essay in a Word document that you can save. Once you are ready (do not forget to spell check and proofread) "cut" and "paste" the text into the essay section of the application form.

3. Print, sign and date your completed application

4. Submit Application

- Enclose BC Student Assistance Program Notification of Assessment.
- Submit application to Student Services at College of the Rockies by June 30, 2010
