

Lieutenant-Governor's Silver Medal

The Lieutenant-Governor's Silver Medal was established in 1979 by the Ministry of Advanced Education. The Medal is awarded to students* in a vocational or career certificate program. Programs that are eligible are determined by the Awards Committee as full-time studies of four months but less than two years at a B.C. public post-secondary school.

The student chosen should be one who has not only excelled in their studies, but also has contributed in a positive way to the life of the College or Institute or to their community. Choosing the recipient is the responsibility of the Scholarship and Awards Committee.

There are two areas to be considered in evaluating students for this Award.

Area	Weighting	Criteria
1.	75%	Academic performance and contribution to the program.
2.	25%	Contribution to the College and Community through volunteering and participation in extra-curricular activities.

Please submit the completed application consisting of the Vocational Student Assessment Form completed by the Instructor and the Student Activity Questionnaire to the Chair of the Scholarship and Awards Committee, Lois Murray – Financial Aid and Awards Officer, by May 4, 2018.

* To apply, a student must be enrolled full-time (min 60% course-load) in a vocational, career, or trades program of not less than four months duration during the 2017/18 academic year (August 1, 2017 to July 31, 2018).
